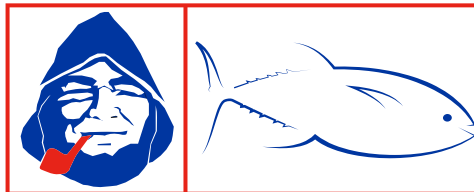
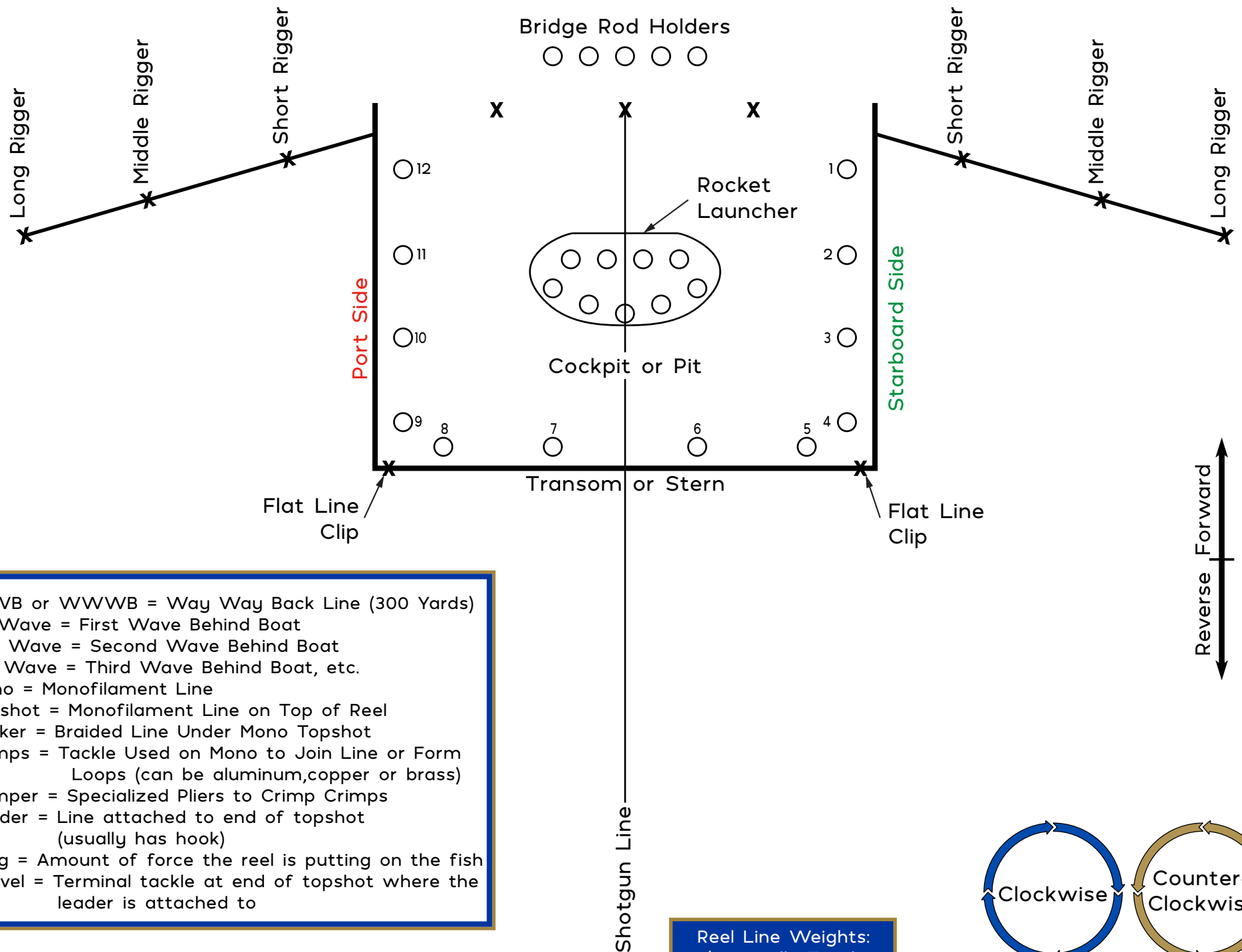

TROLLING SPREADS and TERMINOLOGY





WWB or WWWB = Way Way Back Line (300 Yards)
 1st Wave = First Wave Behind Boat
 2nd Wave = Second Wave Behind Boat
 3rd Wave = Third Wave Behind Boat, etc.
 Mono = Monofilament Line
 Topshot = Monofilament Line on Top of Reel
 Backer = Braided Line Under Mono Topshot
 Crimps = Tackle Used on Mono to Join Line or Form
 Loops (can be aluminum, copper or brass)
 Crimper = Specialized Pliers to Crimp Crimps
 Leader = Line attached to end of topshot
 (usually has hook)
 Drag = Amount of force the reel is putting on the fish
 Swivel = Terminal tackle at end of topshot where the
 leader is attached to

TERMINOLOGY

Reel Line Weights:
 30's - 50 lb. Topshot
 50's - 80 lb. Topshot
 70's - 100 lb. Topshot
